Lakeville Police Crash Involving Pedestrian on Scooter

Lakeville, Minn.—On June 3, 2024, at approximately 3:15 p.m., the Lakeville Police Department responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident involving a pedestrian at the intersection of 179th Street (Dakota County Road 9) and Granby Lane. Officers arrived and determined that a passenger vehicle had collided with a pedestrian on a motorized scooter at this location.

Based upon initial findings, it appears a passenger vehicle was westbound on 179th Street (CR 9) and collided with a pedestrian on a motorized scooter who was crossing 179th from south to north on Granby Lane. This intersection is controlled by stop signs in the north and southbound directions, allowing east and westbound traffic to proceed without traffic control.

The pedestrian on the scooter is a teenage male. He was transported to Hennepin County Medical Center with life-threatening injuries. The driver, and sole occupant, of the passenger vehicle is an adult female and did not report any injuries.

The Lakeville Police Department was assisted at the scene by the Lakeville Fire Department and Allina EMS. The Minnesota State Patrol responded to the scene as well to assist with crash reconstruction.
