Lakeville Police Department respond to domestic disturbance involving a report of an armed suspect

Lakeville, Minn.— On June 27, at approximately 9:35 a.m., the Lakeville Police Department responded to an active domestic situation occurring in a moving vehicle, which eventually ended up at Brackett's Crossing Country Club (17976 Judicial Rd, Lakeville).

Upon arrival at Brackett's Crossing, officers located the victim and the suspect vehicle. Information indicated that the suspect had entered the building and was potentially armed. LPD's initial response prioritized evacuating workers and customers from the building and locating the suspect.

Due to reports of a firearm being involved, the number of bystanders in the area, and the size of area to be searched, several law enforcement agencies responded to assist including SWAT. A shelter-in-place order was issued for the surrounding area to ensure public safety and allow law enforcement to conduct operations effectively.

Law enforcement thoroughly cleared all buildings at Brackett's Crossing and determined the suspect was no longer on the premises. As the investigation progressed and tips were solicited from citizens, the shelter-in-place order was lifted. A short time later, officers responded to a tip and located the 27-year-old male suspect in the 18000 block of Lansford Path. The suspect complied with police commands and was taken into custody without further incident. No firearm was found on his person or in the immediate vicinity.

We extend our gratitude to all assisting agencies, the staff and guests at Brackett's Crossing, and the public for their cooperation and assistance.
