### Lakeville Police Department Investigating Suspected Homicide

Lakeville, Minn.—On June 29, 2024, shortly after 4:00 a.m., Lakeville Police were dispatched to the parking lot of the Amazon Fulfillment Center at 9800 217th Street West, following a report of an altercation.

Upon arrival, officers found an adult male in the parking lot with a suspected gunshot wound. Officers, along with responders from the Lakeville Fire Department and Allina EMS, performed lifesaving efforts, but the male was ultimately declared deceased at the scene.

A second male, 24 years old, was apprehended near the victim by responding officers and remains in custody. At this time, it appears the altercation was limited to these two individuals. Investigators are working to determine their relationship to each other, what led up to the altercation and their specific connection to the business (Amazon).

The identity of the victim, along with the cause and manner of death, will be released by the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office. A firearm was recovered at the scene and there is no known threat to the public related to this incident. The Lakeville Police Department's Investigative and Crime Scene Units are leading the investigation, with assistance from the Dakota County Sheriff's Office Crime Scene Unit.
