Lakeville, Minnesota – On Nov. 8, 2024, at approximately 9 a.m., the Lakeville Police Department responded to a report of a bomb threat directed toward the Wells Fargo Bank at 17365 Kenyon Ave.

Upon receiving the call, officers promptly evacuated the bank and nearby businesses to ensure public safety. The Bloomington Bomb Squad and Airport Police Department's Bomb Detection K-9 were called in to assist with a thorough search of the area. Following a comprehensive sweep, no suspicious items were located. The area is deemed safe, and businesses have since been permitted to resume operations.

The Lakeville Police Department extends our sincere gratitude to our partners – the Lakeville Fire Department, Bloomington Bomb Squad and Airport Police Department's K-9 Unit – for their swift response and collaboration in keeping our community safe.

The investigation into the origin of the threat is continuing. There is no ongoing public safety concern.
