Lakeville Police Department Responds to Crash Involving Pedestrian Struck by Vehicle

Lakeville, Minnesota— On August 7, 2025, shortly before 4:00 p.m., the Lakeville Police Department responded to the intersection of Highview Avenue and 185th Street West on a report of a pedestrian who was struck by a motor vehicle. Responding officers arrived and immediately initiated medical care to the pedestrian, who was displaying significant injuries. The driver of the vehicle involved remained on scene and was not injured.

Preliminary information suggests the vehicle, a Chevrolet Malibu, was northbound on Highview Avenue and proceeded through the roundabout intersection, intending to go westbound on 185th Street West. The pedestrian was in the crosswalk on the west side of the intersection moving northbound on Highview Avenue when she was struck in the westbound lane of 185th Street West. There were no signs of impairment noted with the vehicle's driver, a 44-year-old male.

The victim, a 66-year-old female from Lakeville, was transported via ground ambulance to Hennepin County Medical Center with life-threatening injuries. There are no further updates on her condition at this time.

A Crash Reconstruction Specialist from the Minnesota State Patrol responded to the scene to assist, given the extent of injury. The exact cause of the crash remains under investigation. In addition to the Minnesota State Patrol, the Lakeville Police Department was assisted at the scene by the Lakeville Fire Department and Allina EMS.
